Tournament Information

Golf Course: Chickasaw Pointe Golf Club on Lake Texoma opened October 1999. This 7011-yard Championship layout has rolling hills, picturesque lake views, exquisitely manicured Bermuda grass fairways and Champion Ultra Dwarf greens. The par 72 course offers four sets of tees that give golfers of all skill levels an enjoyable time. Currently, Chickasaw Pointe is ranked top 3 in Oklahoma (public access) since opening. Host Hotel: Choctaw Casino Resort in Durant Oklahoma will be our host hotel. Choctaw Casino Resort is a AAA Four Diamond entertainment destination in Southeastern Oklahoma. It is about 98 miles to Dallas, TX. The rooms are spacious with amazing bathrooms. There is so much to do here! NAGA Tournament: The tournament will be a 54-hole stroke play event. The overall winner must play from the Championship tees. All players have the option to play from the Championship Tees including Seniors for all 3 days. In the event of a tie for the Championship (Men/ Seniors) there will be a sudden death playoff. All other ties will use a card-off process in accordance with the USGA guidelines. Open players not competing for the overall championship can play from blue tees.

Senior Tournament: The Senior tournament will also be a 54-hole stroke play event. Seniors (50-59), Super-Seniors (60-69), and Super-Super-Seniors (70+) will play from the designated Age Appropriate Senior tees.

Clarifying competing for both championships: Please remember these are two different, individual tournaments, the NAGA Open and the NAGA Seniors. Players must declare, when they register, which tournament they wish to compete in. If a Senior, Super-Senior, or Super-Super-Senior wishes to play for the overall Open NAGA tournament title, they **must play from the championship tees** for the duration of the event and will not be competing in the Seniors. If

a Super-Super-Senior wished to play for the overall Senior title they **must play from Senior tees** for the duration of the Senior event.

Eligibility: All NAGA members and Associate members. The field will be limited to 120 golfers, with consideration given first to life members, and then those members who are current with their 2017 NAGA dues. Amputees will have first consideration over associate members if the 120 spots have been filled. If necessary, please include your 2017 NAGA dues with your official tournament application, and check the appropriate box.

Associate Division: There will be an Associate Division for all able bodied participants and persons with non-amputee handicaps. To be eligible the participant must be a NAGA Associate Member in good standing. Awards will be given to the top three participants of the division based on a **NET score with a verified handicap**.

Net Championship: There will be only one award and the winner may come from any Division. Only those who have a **current valid golf handicap** either from the USGA/RCGA or a locally recognized organization will be considered and will be verified prior to the competition. Players that win their division based on gross score are not eligible. *Please fill in the information on your entry form as to your handicap index number and an e-mail/phone number where it can be verified.*

Practice Rounds: Tee times for practice rounds may be made 30 days in advance by calling 580-564-2581 or by going to the web site www.pointe-vistagolf.com. Please identify yourself as a member of NAGA.

Monday Sponsor Scramble/Membership Meeting: Membership meeting and Dinner will be in the Red River Magnolia room at the Choctaw Casino Hotel.

Bag Storage: There will be bag storage available at the golf course for security and tournament convenience. Clubs will be left on the carts and locked up at night. Please help the golf professionals by having a name tag on your bag and generously compensating them for their services.

Dress Code: Chickasaw Pointe is a **soft spike facility**. **Men** are required to wear golf shirts with collars and sleeves, and either slacks or shorts of appropriate length. **Women** can wear slacks, shorts, culottes, and golf skirts of the appropriate length with golf shirts (sleeveless tops for ladies are permitted).

Check and Credit Card Payments

The following policy will apply to any payment to NAGA for dues, entry fees or miscellaneous charges for returned checks or denial of payment on credit card remittances. A letter or e-mail will be sent to notify the payer that the check or credit card charge has been denied. The notification will specify that the amount due must be paid by certified check or money order (in U. S. funds) to satisfy the obligation. If a payment is rejected for a tournament entry fee, **the entry will be denied** until the obligation is paid. The member will be placed in “non-member status” until all obligations are satisfied, including a fee of \$ 25.00 U.S. added to all applicable charges of rejected check/credit card.

Late Entries: Entry Deadline: July 31st, 2017. Late entrants are accepted based on availability. They may or may not receive a tournament golf shirt in the size requested or other items ordered before deadline.

Refund Policy: No full refund of fees will be made after July 31st, 2017.
