ATTENTION!!!

Please take note and read this entire document as there are new changes this year!

- Pace of play policy under tournament information to follow later in document.
- If you intend on bringing a caddie or player assistant on the entry form.
- Championship (Open) Division will be played between 6400 - 6700 yards. If you do not wish to compete in the Championship (Open) Division you will play from a teeing distance of roughly 6000 -6100 yards, and still be able to compete within your division (AK, BK, Assisted, etc), but not for the overall Championship. Senior's and Women will play from their standard yardage. There will be shortened yardages for other "disability" categories.
- If you wish to attend the Welcome Reception but do not want to play in the Scramble, just enter the total number (Including yourself) in "Guest" area.
- *Entry fee will be reduced \$25 dollars if you sign up before June 14,2020!*

Tournament Information**

GOLF COURSE: **Walt Disney World® Golf's Magnolia** Golf Course, is a tour caliber par-72, measuring at 7,516 yards from the black tournament teeing grounds with Bermuda grass throughout the course. The course is located just outside of *Disney's Magic Kingdom* and hosted the PGA Tour's **Walt Disney World® Open Invitational** (1974-1981) and the **Walt Disney World® Golf Classic** (2007-2012). The **Walt Disney World®** Resort offers various activities for participants and their families: 4 Theme Parks, 2 Water Parks, shopping, dining, pools, fishing, and much more!

TOURNAMENT: The tournament will be a 54-hole stroke play event for the invited qualifying players. In the event of a tie for the Championship (Men/Ladies/Seniors) there will be a sudden death playoff beginning on hole #1. All other ties will use a scorecard-playoff process in accordance with the USGA guidelines. The Overall Gross and Net Champion will come from the Championship Tees. All players have the option to play from the Championship Tees including Ladies and Seniors for all 3 days. **Note to all participants: If you wish to compete for the overall NAGA Championship you MUST play all three days, scoring from the Championship Tees for 54 holes.** Seniors (50-59), Super Seniors (60-69), and Super-Super Seniors (70+) will play from the signified Senior Tees. The Senior Championship will be a 36-hole tournament with Tuesday being a practice round and Wednesday and Thursday being the scoring rounds. **Please signify on the Entry Form if you will be playing in the Senior Championship ONLY.** To clarify: If a Senior, Super Senior, Super-Super Senior wishes to play for the Overall Championship they **MUST PLAY** from the Championship Tees and score 54 holes.

ELIGIBILITY: All NAGA members, Associate members, and participants competing in the WR4GD Ranking Event. Current NAGA membership is required for participation in the tournament. If necessary, please include your 2020 NAGA dues with your official tournament application and check the appropriate box. **SAVE \$25 SIGNING UP BEFORE: JUNE 14, 2020.**
FINAL DEADLINE: AUGUST 14th, 2020.

ASSOCIATE DIVISION: There will be an Associate Division for all non-amputees. To be eligible the participant must be a NAGA Associate Member in good standing. Awards will be given to the top three participants of the overall Championship Division, with also one Senior Associate Division Champion. *Amputees will get first in line while Associate members' entry forms will be date stamped and they will be notified via e-mail that their entry form has been received. First in wins the slot. Associates will be notified via e-mail that they are in the tournament.*

SUBMISSION OF ENTRY: You can submit your entry form and payment (PREFERABLY check.....or credit card information) to **Deryck Jernigan** (Information found on Official Entry Form page). All payments must be paid in US Dollars and paid to the National Amputee Golf Championship.

LATE ENTRIES: Tournament Entry Applications received after the entry deadline of AUGUST 14th, 2020 will be accommodated on a first-come-first-serve basis. Late entrants may or may not receive tournament merchandise, and will also be subject to paying a late fee. All entries will be confirmed by e-mail. The committee is working on some exciting ideas and additional information about the tournament will be passed along with your confirmation e-mail. Please be sure your e-mail address is indicated LEGIBLY on the entry form.

REFUND POLICY: No full refund of fees will be made after August 14th, 2020. Should a cancellation of entry and request for refund become necessary, a written request including the reason for the request should be e-mailed to **Adam Benza** at adambenza@yahoo.com or mailed to **1886 Mill Run Ct, Hellertown, PA 18055** for consideration.

PRACTICE ROUNDS: Practice rounds can be booked for play up to 7 days in advance of the event by calling (407)-939-4653. The rate is \$49 per person +tax, and is valid daily after 11:00 A.M. Please notify them that you are with the National Amputee Golf Association.

MONDAY – SPONSOR SCRAMBLE: There will be a Monday, September 21st, 2020, Sponsor Scramble with a shotgun start at 1:00 P.M. The Fee to play in the event is \$80. *Guests will be welcome to play at a fee of \$90, if there are spots available.*

BAG STORAGE: There will be bag storage at *Disney's Magnolia* Golf Course for security and tournament convenience. *Please help our golf professionals by using the bag storage and generously compensating them for their services.*

GOLF HANDICAP: A NET Champion will be determined at the National Championship in 2020. There will be only one award and the winner may come from **ANY DIVISION**. Only those who have a current valid golf handicap either from the USGA/RCGA or a locally recognized organization will be considered and must be verified prior to competition play commencing. *Please fill in the information on your entry form as to your handicap index number, and an e-mail/phone number where it can be verified.*

DRESS CODE: "Proper golf attire is required on all the courses. For men, proper golf attire consists of a polo-style shirt with collar, turtleneck or mock turtleneck shirt, and slacks or Bermuda-length shorts. For women, proper golf attire consists of polo-style shirt with collar or other suitable shirt or blouse with or without a collar, and slacks, skirt or Bermuda-length shorts. Golf shoes with metal spike alternatives are required; however soft-soled shoes and tennis shoes are acceptable."

PRACTICE FACILITIES: Pre-round range balls, daily, are included in the competition fee.

PACE OF PLAY: Walt Disney World® Golf Courses are committed to maintaining a reasonable pace of play. Should your play not meet the pace of play requirements appropriate action will be taken (A 4 1/2 hour pace is acceptable, 15 minutes per hole). *Participants should arrive at least 45 minutes prior to play commencing to allow for sufficient time to warm-up on the range, then to be in their golf carts 20 minutes prior to hear the tournament announcements. Carts shall leave the staging area headed out onto the course 10 minutes prior to the scheduled start time.* ****In the event of not meeting pace of play requirements, the participant(s) slowing play may receive penalty strokes.****

It features two pools, inside and outside restaurant and bars, and transportation to and from *Disney Theme Parks*.

Room rates will remain the same for 3 days prior/3 days after the event (Rooms are blocked for September 20th-24th, 2020).

A deposit equal to one night's room and tax will be charged at the time a guest makes a room reservation, and upon check-in this will be applied towards the guest's bill. [Check and Credit Card Payments](#)

As a service to our members, payment of dues and entry fees for tournaments is available by personal check and credit card. The average charge to NAGA for credit card charges is 6%. In recent years, returned checks and denial of payment on credit card charges have become more pronounced and much time is being expended to resolve the issue.

Beginning January 1, 2003, the following policy will apply to any payment to NAGA for dues, entry fees or miscellaneous charges for returned checks or denial of payment on credit card remittances:

A letter or e-mail will be sent to notify the player that the check or credit card charge has been denied. The notification will specify that the amount due must be paid by a certified check or money order (US funds) to satisfy the obligation. If a payment is rejected for a tournament entry fee, **the entry will be denied** until the obligation is paid. The member will be placed in "non-member status" until all obligations are satisfied, including a fee of \$25.00 US added to all applicable charges of rejected check/credit card.

Should the NAGA member fail to rectify within thirty (30) days of notification, a new application for membership and the appropriate fees will have to be made for reinstatement.

Denial of Entry means that the entry to the event is not accepted. In the case where entries are limited by player spot availability, it could result in not participating in the event.
